What is the CARES Act?

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act offers assistance to any non-residential facility by encouraging investment in facility upgrades.

How does it apply to my building?

Any non-structural improvements made to an interior portion of a non-residential building, including to HVAC systems, are eligible for a 100% tax deduction in 2021 with NO limitation on project cost.

You have access to even more relief funding! This year, Congress approved a \$908 Billion pandemic relief bill with over \$82 billion being allocated to educational facilities: Four times more funding than in the March 2020 CARES Act.

What does this mean for my facility?

According to the Consolidated Appropriations Act, this money can be used to inspect, test, maintain, repair, replace, and upgrade HVAC systems to improve indoor air quality in preparation for safe reopening and classroom reoccupation.
